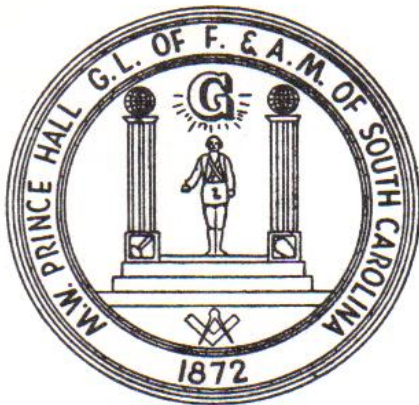

The Prince Hall family in order to become more understood and appreciated within the communities we live will schedule our public programs as sit-in services in local churches. Programs (such as: St. John’s Day, Star Day, Prince Hall Day, Jubilee Day, and etc) should be held in a church during morning services. The Mary B. Thomas Girls and the Knights of Pythagoras Boys should be invited to attend all functions. (Note: Discuss constitutional and size conflicts with the Grand Master)

Money raised during the Church programs and visitations shall be donated to a youth group of the church. (i.e. Youth Choir, Young People Department etc) The goal is to support our youth, inspire the youth of the church to join our youth groups and to inspire the adults to become Masons and Eastern Stars.

Our Heritage is vanishing as our senior members cross over to the other side. We must capture our history, which requires our research. Each District Deputy is to research and record the history of his District. Each Worshipful Master is to research and record the history of his Lodge. Each Worshipful master should encourage his members to research and record the history of their particular family. All histories of Districts and Lodges should be submitted to the Grand Lodge Historian for inclusion in the book: “History of Prince Hall Masonry in South Carolina.

**Worshipful Masters** are elected to serve the craft and should attend all meetings. If the Worshipful is unable to attend he should send a warden or someone from his lodge. However, the Worshipful should inform his Special Deputy or Deputy as to the reason why he can't attend. If the Worshipful fails to comply, he should be sent a letter of warning the first time. If he fails to attend another meeting without notifying the Special Deputy or Deputy or having someone represents his lodge, he is to be **fined \$20.00**. The fine money is to be **donated to the Knights of Pythagoras**.

**Worshipful Masters** should not be in office to learn what the master of a lodge should know. He should and must be learning those things while he is Junior and Senior Warden.

Therefore we have instituted what we are calling "**Worshipful Master Basic Training**" which consists of a 100-question test. If the Junior and Senior Wardens are not willing to move to the east, they should not be in that station. A **Warden** elected to Worshipful Master must pass the test prior to receiving Past Master Degree. The **Worshipful Master, Special Deputy, and District Deputy** are responsible for training wardens.

**Worshipful Masters** wishing to become a Special Deputy must pass the Worshipful Master Basic Training test and pass the District Deputy Basic Training test after it is instituted in 2010

**Traveling cards:** The Secretary should include the highest rank obtained by a brother on his traveling card. (Such as WM, SW, PM, DD, RWGSW etc.) The card must contain the seal of the Lodge.

**Special Deputies** should check each lodge for: Presents of Lodge Seal, an official minute book, Do the lodge have or sponsor a Knights of Pythagoras Council and for Security Bond on Worshipful Master, Secretary and Treasurer.

**Military Service:** Each Worshipful Master is to provide the Committee on Military Relations a list of names and **military addresses** of all Master Masons serving on military active duty.

- The **Secretary** is to place the **highest office** a brother has **held** on his Masonic **Traveling Card.** (Example: DDGM Sam Jones or SW Sam Smith)
- Each Worshipful Master provide the **addresses of Masons** in the **military** to the Chairman of the **Committee on Military Relations.**

to support the Knights of Pythagoras

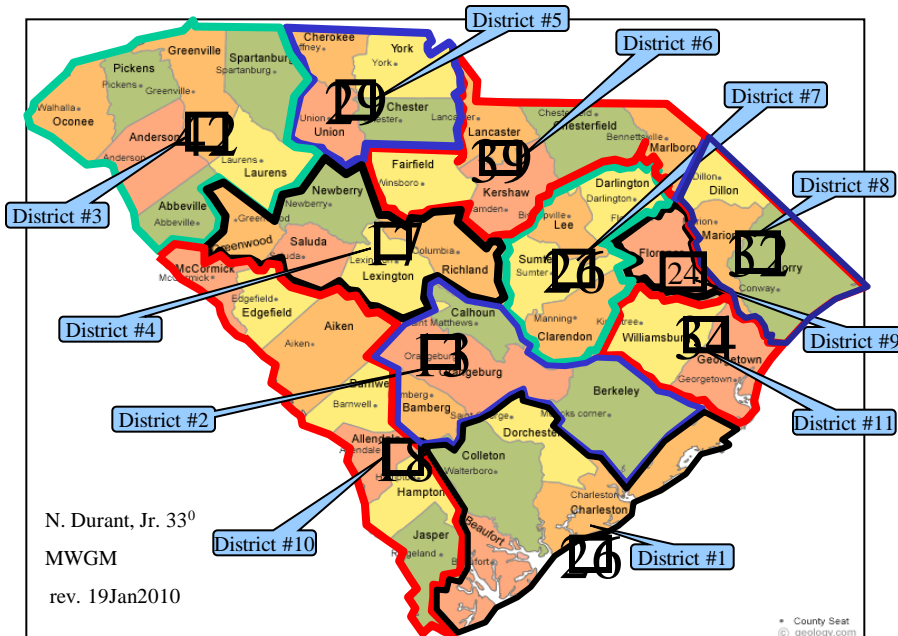
Sponsored by MWPHGL Grand Trustees

- **Provide correspondence** from the Prince Hall Grand Lodge of South Carolina to every Master Mason serving on active duty.
- **Sponsor a Masons** in the **military recognition** program at the Prince Hall Grand Lodge of South Carolina and at several military institutions within South Carolina.
- Incorporate all branches of military servicemen.
  - (Army, Navy, Marine, Air Force, Coast Guard, National Guard, Army Reserve, Merchant Marines)

## Committee on Life Membership

- **Organization:** On the **Grand Lodge level** the program coordinator is the **RWJGW**, on the **District level**, the **Deputy @ Large on Life Membership** and a **Committee on Life Membership** appointed by the **District Deputy**. We recommend that each **Worshipful Master** establish a **Life Membership Program** for his Lodge if it does not already exist.
- **Life Membership:** A **Prince Hall Master Mason** with **Fifty (50)** or more years of **service** or **Seventy-five (75)** or more years of **age**, whichever comes first.
- **RW Junior Grand Warden:** **Sponsor** a program on the **second night** of the **Annual Grand Lodge Communication** styled: “**Amateur Night at the Grand Lodge**” to **support** the Senior Masons **Life Membership fund** of the Prince Hall Grand Lodge of South Carolina. **Establish a Data Base** for the Grand Lodge with the, **Name, Age, and Date of Raising** for all Prince Hall Masons in South Carolina.
- **Deputy @ Large on Life Membership shall:** **Obtain** a list of **Names, Date of Birth** and **Date of Raising** for all **Prince Hall Master Masons** in the District assigned and **forward** the information to the **RW Junior Grand Warden**. **Sponsor** a **program** in the **District assigned** in cooperation with the **District Deputy** to support the life members in the District assigned. **Assist** the **District Deputy** in getting a **talent entry** to **represent** the District at the Annual Communication.
- **District Deputy: Participation;** Each **Masonic District** should provide, an **Amateur talent entry** to the Grand Lodge Annual Communication to represent the **Masons** of that **District** and to **Support the Life Membership Program**. The **District Deputy** shall provide the **Name** and **Lodge number** of the **Master Mason** with the **Most years in Service**, **Most Years in Age**, and the **Oldest Worshipful Master** of his District to the **RWJGW** and **MWGM** by the **15th of November** each year.

- **Protocol:** When giving the Protocol for the Grand Lodge of South Carolina, recognize the Head of other Houses by **Name** if they are present. (Recognize Grand Master & Grand Worthy Matron by name if present or not)
